Training and Enforcement of COTPA by Delhi Police - MIF Initiative

The Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003 or COTPA, 2003 prohibits advertisement of, and provides for the regulation of trade and commerce in, and production, supply and distribution of cigarettes and other tobacco products in India.

We are happy to see the enforcement of the act by Delhi Police under our campaign against tobacco with Sambandh Health Foundation. So far, police personnel of five districts of Delhi have been trained and are active in implementation and fining of defaulters. The "No smoking" signs are also visible at most shops in Delhi.

Awareness session on anti tobacco was organised for over 800 students of Raisina Bengali School, C R Park, New Delhi


